Covid-19 Policies, Procedures, & Rules
Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, the Ross Community Center is taking additional health and safety precautions in order to provide a safe and healthy place for programs, events and services. All participants and persons on our premises must abide by the additional health and safety precautions listed below.
Participants must be clear of any illness or Covid-19 symptoms. Verbal health screenings should be conducted a school and at home.
Every participant will have their temperature taken upon arrival at the Ross Community Center.
Parents will be asked if anyone in their household has any symptoms (fever, headache, cough, shortness of breath, musches, and sore throat, among others). Any individual with symptoms, or individuals with symptomatic persons in their household, will be asked to stay at home and will not be allowed to enter the facilities.
Participants will be required to wear masks while at the center during programming. During strenuous activity, masks can be taken off, but participants will continue to be spaced at a minimum of six feet apart.
Participants will be spaced at a minimum of six feet apart at all times, indoors and outdoors.
Participants will wash their hands upon arrival to the center, before and after completion of activities. Portable sinks will be available for outdoor activities, and bathrooms are available inside the building. Hand sanitizer will be readily available at all times.
Surfaces will be thoroughly disinfected and sanitized before participants arrive. Participants will be asked to disinfect their particular surface after use. Surfaces will be sanitized between classes.
High-risk individuals will be discouraged from attending the Ross Community Center (individuals 65 and older, and individuals who are immune compromised).
No activity supplies, materials or equipment sharing. Should there be sharing of sports equipment, equipment wibe disinfected between use.
Participants should only drink out of their own water containers, preferably brought from home and pre-labeled. Should a child not have his/her own container, we will have water bottles readily available for each child participating in our programs, and each water bottle will be labeled with the child's name before handing it to them. Drinks should be stored at a minimum of 6ft. apart.
